





Mary Ethel's Basket

Mary Ethel Emmanuel represented the State of Nebraska as a Midwest Travel Writers Association Associate member from 1991 to 2006. She served on the board and in numerous volunteer positions over the years. Her wildly curly hair and infectious laugh were a constant presence at every meeting. Nebraska's first winery opened in 2002, which coincided with the fall meeting in Sonoma County, California. Not one to be intimidated by the great California wine region, Mary Ethel suggested that instead of giving our hosts a silver plate in appreciation for their work on behalf of our organization, all members bring a little gift representing their individual communities in the Midwest. Mary Ethel wanted to show off Nebraska wine.

Until her death in 2006 at the age of 54, Mary Ethel coordinated these gift baskets of appreciation, which are now named in her honor.

MTJA Players



MEMBERSHIP

There are two categories of MTJA membership, Active and Associate. An applicant's category of membership must accurately reflect the person's source of professional travel-related income and ethical allegiance. No member shall hold both Active and Associate memberships.

Active Members are on-staff and independent editors, writers, bloggers, and photojournalists residing in the Association's membership area who earn their income from the creation of travel-related editorial content for newspapers, magazines, books, blogs, websites, radio or television. Excluded work includes advertorials and copy for promotional brochures, (i.e., content that is paid for and approved by advertisers or sponsoring organizations).

Associate Members reside in the Association's membership area and are engaged primarily in public relations within the travel industry and have worked regularly with the travel media for a minimum of one year. Marketing and public relations staff of single-location attractions are not eligible for membership.

CODE OF ETHICS

Members of MTJA adhere to the highest standards in the profession of journalism. In accepting and continuing in membership, each member agrees to abide by the Code of Professional Responsibility.


